Team members raise more than \$100,000 for United Way

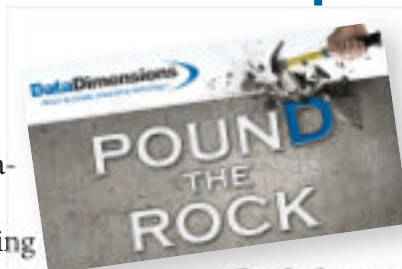
Data Dimensions team members gave generously during the 2016 United Way campaign, raising more than \$100,000 to help agencies that benefit people in need in their communities.

### 2017 'Pound the Rock' theme emphasizes determination

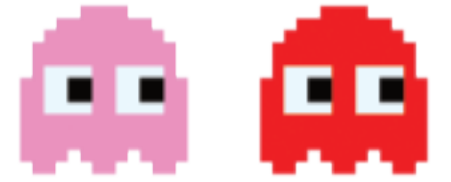

## Data Dimensions opens sales office in Madison

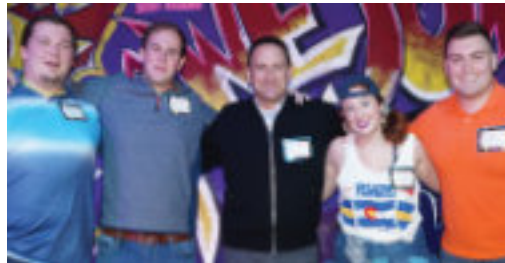

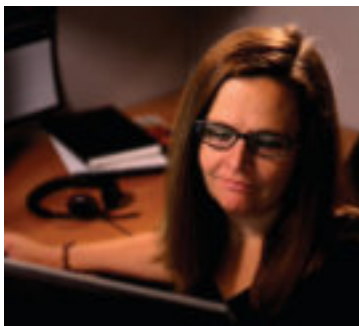
